Applications are invited for the above position in the Mathematical Institute. Candidates should have the potential to achieve international recognition for their research in an area which enhances and extends our current research strengths. They should have well developed plans for attracting external research funding.

Teaching duties include courses for mathematics majors and trainee teachers, as well as service teaching.

This is a four-year fixed-term position. A two-year extension is possible, conditional on a positive evaluation of your achievements in research, teaching and administration. Should it subsequently be possible to appoint you to a permanent position, then it would not be necessary to advertise that position (§78(1) ThürHG).

Candidates must hold an above average PhD and have demonstrated their potential for research of international excellence through additional publications. They should be skilled at teaching. Experience at universities in more than one country would be welcomed. Suitably qualified applicants are invited to send their applications to:
